## PREPARATION FOR FURTHER EDUCATION/3RD LEVEL

Co. Kilkenny VEC's Back to Education Initiative (BTEI) is now accepting applications from BTEI eligible applicants interested in participating on part-time FETAC accredited programmes due to commence in November 2011. Classes are FREE OF CHARGE to all participants in receipt of a Social Welfare payment and/or a Medical Card and/or signing for credits. Those not currently in the labour market (who were recently self-employed) will also be considered.

The following modules are specifically aimed at applicants with Leaving Certificate standard of education (or higher) who are considering applying for a PLC and/or 3rd Level place in 2012, and who would benefit from participating on some taster modules:
